Faith & Breakthrough

How to Use This Devotional

Daily Practice:

1. Begin each day with prayer, asking God to speak to you through His Word
2. Read the three scriptures for that day slowly and meditatively
3. Speak each affirmation aloud with faith and conviction
4. Spend time in reflection, journaling, or prayer about how these truths apply to your current situation when challenges arise
5. Carry these truths with you throughout the day, meditating on them

Weekly Reflection: At the end of the week, look back on the seven days and consider:

- How has your faith grown?
- What breakthroughs have you experienced or are you believing for?
- Which scriptures and affirmations resonated most deeply with you?

Remember: Faith is not just believing God can do something, but trusting that He will do what's best according to His perfect timing and plan. May this devotional strengthen your faith and position you for the breakthroughs God has in store for you.

7 Days of Faith & Breakthrough: A 7-Day Devotional

A journey of spiritual growth through scripture, reflection, and affirmation

Day 1: Foundation of Faith

Scripture 1: Hebrews 11:1 (NIV)

"Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see."

Affirmation: I walk confidently in faith, trusting in God's promises even when I cannot see the path ahead.

"Scripture 2: Romans 10:17 (NIV)

Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ."

Affirmation: My faith grows stronger as I immerse myself in God's Word and listen to His voice.

"Scripture 3: Mark 9:23 (NIV)

'If you can'?' said Jesus. 'Everything is possible for one who believes.'"

Affirmation: I believe that all things are possible through God, and I embrace His limitless power in my life.

Day 2: Breakthrough Through Prayer

Scripture 4: Jeremiah 33:3 (NIV)

"Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know."

Affirmation: I call upon God with confidence, knowing He will reveal great and mighty things to me.

Scripture 5: Matthew 7:7-8 (NIV)

"Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened."

Affirmation: I persistently seek God's will, knowing that He opens doors of opportunity and blessing for me.

Scripture 6: 1 John 5:14-15 (NIV)

"This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked for."

Affirmation: I pray with confidence, knowing God hears me and will answer according to His perfect will.

Day 3: Moving Mountains

Scripture 7: Matthew 17:20 (NIV)

He replied," Because you have so little faith. Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you."

Affirmation: My faith, though small, has the power to move mountains and accomplish the impossible.

Scripture 8: Mark 11:22-24 (NIV)

"'Have faith in God,' Jesus answered. 'Truly I tell you, if anyone says to this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and does not doubt in their heart but believes that what they say will happen, it will be done for them. Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.'"

Affirmation: I speak to my mountains with authority, believing without doubt that God will move them.

Scripture 9: Luke 1:37 (NIV)

"For no word from God will ever fail."

Affirmation: I stand on God's promises knowing that His word never fails and His plans for me will come to pass.

Day 4: Strength in Weakness

Scripture 10: 2 Corinthians 12:9 (NIV)

"But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me."

Affirmation: In my weakness, God's strength is made perfect, and His grace is sufficient for every challenge I face.

Scripture 11: Isaiah 40:31 (NIV)

"But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint."

Affirmation: As I wait on the Lord, He renews my strength and empowers me to soar above every obstacle.

Scripture 12: Philippians 4:13 (NIV)

"I can do all this through him who gives me strength."

Affirmation: I can accomplish all things through Christ who strengthens me and equips me for victory.

Day 5: Divine Favor and Open Doors

Scripture 13: Deuteronomy 28:6 (NIV)

"You will be blessed when you come in and blessed when you go out."

Affirmation: God's favor surrounds me like a shield, blessing my coming and going in every area of my life.

Scripture 14: Revelation 3:8 (NIV)

"I know your deeds. See, I have placed before you an open door that no one can shut. I know that you have little strength, yet you have kept my word and have not denied my name."

Affirmation: God opens doors for me that no one can shut, creating pathways of opportunity and blessing.

Scripture 15: Psalm 5:12 (NIV)

"Surely, Lord, you bless the righteous; you surround them with your favor as with a shield."

Affirmation: I am surrounded by God's favor, which protects me and opens doors of divine opportunity.

Day 6: Victory Over Fear

Scripture 16: Joshua 1:9 (NIV)

"Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."

Affirmation: I am strong and courageous because God is with me wherever I go, and I will not be afraid.

Scripture 17: Isaiah 41:10 (NIV)

"So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

Affirmation: I will not fear because God strengthens, helps, and upholds me with His mighty hand.

Scripture 18: 2 Timothy 1:7 (NIV)

"For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline."

Affirmation: God has given me a spirit of power, love, and sound mind, not fear or timidity.

Day 7: Breakthrough and New Beginnings

Scripture 19: Isaiah 43:19 (NIV)

"See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland."

Affirmation: God is doing a new thing in my life, making a way where there seems to be no way.

Scripture 20: 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NIV)

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!"

Affirmation: I am a new creation in Christ; old things have passed away, and all things have become new.

Scripture 21: Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV)

""For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, 'plans to prosper you and not to harm you, to give you hope and a future.'"

Affirmation: God has good plans for my future, plans to prosper me and give me hope and a bright tomorrow.
